Dear Parent/Carer

As no doubt you are aware, there is a day of action by several public sector unions on Wednesday, 30th November. All schools and many other organisations will be affected differently according to the numbers of staff they have in unions which have balloted for action, and the numbers of staff in those unions who follow their union advice. This will impact upon school. There are a significant number of staff whose unions have indicated they will be on strike on that day.

Given the numbers of staff who will not be reporting for duty on the 30th November, the school will be closed for students. Those staff who are not on strike will report to work and carry out duties prescribed to them.

It is understood that parents/carers need to make arrangements for their children and it is with this in mind that the school is giving as early an indication as possible of the impact of industrial action on the 30th November.
